Methodology of the training

Trainees will be offered training in crucial skills for the 5 job roles, with the guidance of a group of experts composed of scientists and practitioners, benefiting from the interactions among them. Participants will have different nationalities and academic/ professional

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backgrounds. The group will consist of about 20 trainees from **Germany**, **France**, **Italy and Poland**. Program of the training contains: **minilectures**, **workshops**, **and consultancies with experts**. The default language for the training is English.

Costs

The training is free of charge. Costs of travel to Wrocław and accommodation will be covered by the funds of e-Comma Programme.

Place and dates

The training will be arranged in Wroclaw (Poland) at Wrocław University of Economics, which is ranked among the top economic schools of higher education in Poland and an important centre of science and research. The training will have duration of 5 full days (8 lesson hours per day). The training will take place from 9th till 13th April 2018.

Tourist attractions

The city of Wroclaw is one of the highlights of Poland, and the entire central European region. It boasts fascinating architecture, many rivers and bridges, and a lively metropolitan cultural scene. It was an European Capital Culture 2016. Its theatres, clubs, museums and galleries provide a continuous series of artistic events. You will have the opportunity to visit Wroclaw with a guide and walk along the trail of Wroclaw's Dwarfs, see the stunning market, the Mutual Respect District, Four Denominations District and many Wroclaw's works of

architecture and Wroclaw's nature. You will learn Wroclaw's history and legends. The next day you will take part in the cruise along Odra river and admire the architecture of Wroclaw at night.

Wroclaw's area is famous for its beautiful landscapes and numerous castles. You will see one of them - Książ Castle. It is a huge architectural complex on a scale unique in Europe, situated on a rocky promontory deep in the forest. By virtue of its rich history and remarkable size, the building has been entered on the list of historic sites recognized by the National Heritage Institute. As a residential complex, Książ is recognized as the largest in Lower Silesia.
